

Basic Licensing Units for Security Licence

Introduction

Basic Licensing Units (BLUs) are compulsory WSQ security courses required to apply for a security licence in Singapore. (Unless exempted by the Police Licensing and Regulatory Department (PLRD) of the Singapore Police Force.). The BLUs are.

- Guard and Patrol, Access Control Management: Provide Guard and Patrol Services and Operate Basic Security Equipment (PGPS & OBSE)
- · Incident Response: Handle Security Incidents and Services (HSIS)
- · Threat Observation: Recognise Terrorist Threats (RTT)

Provide Guard and Patrol Services and Operate Basic Security Equipment (PGPS &OBSE) is one of the three mandatory Basic Licensing Units (BLUs) needed to get a security licence in Singapore. This integrated enhanced module is designed to equip participants with the relevant skillset to perform guard and patrol duties. It entails the preparation of work activities, take over to hand over procedures, patrol procedures, operating alarm monitoring equipment as well as learning to write security reports using technology and systems to deliver higher quality security solutions.

Objectives

To demonstrate mastery of the tasks in this course, the participants must be able to do the following within the given time limit and with the materials, tools and equipment supplied:

- Prepare for Duty.
- Operate access control systems.
- Static Guard Duty
- Handle telephone calls and lost-and-found properties.
- Patrol premises
- Operate alarm monitoring equipment.
- Hand over duties.



Entry Requirements

- Be able to read, write and speak English at WSQ WPL Level 3
- Be able to read from a computer monitor or tablet.
- Possess basic skills in operating a computer or tablet.
- Individuals who do not meet the above entry requirements will be subjected to interview before acceptance.
