Threat Observation: Recognise Terrorist Threats is one of the three mandatory Basic Licensing Units (BLUs) needed to get a security licence in Singapore. It is designed to equip participants with the knowledge to recognise and deal with different types of terrorist threats.

With effect from 1 July 2023, all security officers must complete **Threat Observation: Recognise Terrorist Threats** training before they can be deployed at any site.

Objectives

To demonstrate mastery of the tasks in this course, the participants must be able to do the following within the given time limit and with the materials, tools and equipment supplied:

- Describe contemporary terrorist threats
- Identify person-borne threats
- Identify vehicle-borne threats
- Identify object-based threats

Entry Requirements

- Be able to read, write and speak English at WSQ WPL Level 4
- Manipulate numbers at WPN Level 4
 - Individuals who do not meet the above entry requirements will be subjected to interview before acceptance
